A MESSAGE FROM OUR PRINCIPAL....

Happy New Year! It was nice to see all of the boys and girls back at school. I hope everyone had a relaxing, healthy break. With the start of the new year, let us make our new year's resolutions include the following:

1. Children should not be calling home for forgotten items. If it is difficult to gather everything in the morning and arrive at school on time, try packing the backpack the night before and include notes to remind themselves to bring instruments, lunches, etc.
2. With half of the school year passed, children should be able to walk to their classrooms without parents accompanying them.
3. Parents MUST stop in the office anytime they enter the building. You must sign in, be acknowledged by an office staff member and obtain a visitor badge if there is a need to be in the building. This is a safety issue to ensure that everyone in the building belongs in the building.
4. Late students are late and must stop in the office with an adult to get an office pass. They are not considered "on time" if parents walk their children directly to their classroom after the tardy bell. Students will be sent back to the office to sign in properly (with an adult) and receive their late pass. They can then proceed to their classroom.

By working together, we can help our children gain the independence needed to become a confident, well-adjusted student!

KINDERGARTEN ROUND UP



If you have a child who will be five years old on or before December 1, 2012, please call the school office at 248-823-3500 to place your child on our kindergarten list. Registration packets will be sent home in February to all of those on our list, containing information about our programs along with forms to be completed and returned as soon as possible. You may also pick up these packets in our office at the end of February. Please note that documents required for registration are:

- An original birth certificate, hospital record or other proof of birth;
- 3 Proofs of residency - purchase agreement, lease, closing papers, property tax statement), and 2 utility bills with your name and address,
- A health appraisal with up-to-date immunization information is required by the first day of school. Parents may want to begin early by making appointments to visit their child's doctor and/or the Oakland County Health Department for needed immunizations.
- Vision test or Screening.

All Day Kindergarten

The Troy School District will offer free, full-day Kindergarten beginning in the 2012-2013 school year. This is the recommended program for all students as we feel it will provide the most benefit to our young students. However, depending on parental interest, the district will offer a small number of sections of half-day programming with location(s) to be determined. You may indicate your preference of half-day/developmental kindergarten to building principals and office staff, but final decisions will be made at a later date.

We recommend that parents attend the presentation from Mrs. Joan Firestone, the Early Childhood Director at Oakland Schools, regarding all day kindergarten at 7:00 pm on February 15th at the Services Building located at 4420 Livernois. She will also be able to answer any questions you may have at that time.



WINTER WEATHER

As a reminder, the Troy School District will not close schools unless weather and road conditions are hazardous to children's safety. During weather or other emergencies, residents are requested to stay tuned to major radio and television stations for information about school closings: WJR (760 AM), WWJ (950 AM), and WXYT (1270 AM); Channels 2, 4, 5, 6 & 7; or access the internet at the Troy School District website at www.troy.k12.mi.us. A message will also be sent through the district School Messenger system.

Also, please remember that all students should be prepared to play outside, so all children should be dressed in appropriate outer apparel, including boots, gloves, hats and a warm coat. For your reference, please see the chart used to determine outside/inside recess.

Above 20° – recess is held outside

From 15-20° – wind conditions determine outside or inside recess

Below 15° – students will remain indoors
